

LOCAL ACCOMMODATIONS



(Weaverville/Junction City)

Weaverville Hotel and Emporium is an elegant hotel in historic downtown Weaverville. The hotel was originally built in 1861, and has been recently restored, attempting to recapture as much of the original charm as possible. The building is on the National Register of Historic Places. The rates include privileges at the White Wolf Gym across the street, and a voucher of \$5/per person/per night for breakfast in any local establishment. There is, within a two block radius, a coffee house, several good restaurants, two antique stores, the recently renovated Trinity Theatre, several art galleries, the historic Chinese Joss House, and the Jake Jackson Museum and Blacksmith. Their Emporium features fine chocolates, old books and photos, antique reproduction silver jewelry and collectibles, European fragrances and soaps, retro-style clothing, and other gift items. Gonpa visitors receive a very special rate - \$90 to \$150, depending on the room. If they are not busy, they are happy to also upgrade without charge. This rate is the same for weekdays or weekends. The Whitmore Inn is a beautifully restored bed and breakfast inn, built originally in 1895 by millwright, John Whitmore, and listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Located in historical downtown Weaverville, it is within walking distance of many restaurants, shops, museums and galleries. There are three rooms available with queen beds upstairs, and a handicapped accessible room with a double bed and private bath downstairs. Rates are \$125 to \$145 and include individual vouchers of \$8.00 per day for breakfast in local establishments. A 20% discount is offered to Gonpa visitors. Trinity Canyon Lodge is the only motel in Junction City. They give us "preferred customer rates of 10% off, so please tell them you are attending an event at Chagdud Gonpa." It is located 5 miles west on Route 299 right on the Trinity River. **These fares include taxes.** Nice motel rooms run \$49.95 to \$69.95/for 1 or 2 people. There are cabins with kitchens that run from \$79.95 to \$89.95 for 3 and 4 people. A 2 bedroom suite for up to 8 people rents for \$134.95/night. Extra fold out beds are available for \$10 per person. Proprietors are Janet and Richard Starr. Call (800) 354-9297 or check their website www.trinitycanyonlodge.com.

Red Hill Motel is located about 8 miles west of Junction City in Weaverville. It's the only motel that is enough off the highway to reduce highway noise. There are several cabins, three housekeeping units with kitchens, and is within moderate walking distance of stores and restaurants. The rooms are simple but clean and quiet. Single rooms with tax are \$32. Rates for two people run from \$37.25 to \$84/night depending on the room. Extra people are \$5/person. The room for \$84 accommodates 5 people and has a full kitchen. There is no charge for children 11 years or younger. Call Patty at (530) 623-4331 or check their website www.redhillresorts.com.

The 49er Gold Country Inn is located on Main St. in Weaverville. It is a close walk to several restaurants, the museum and the Highland Arts Center. We've had a lot of good feedback from Rigdzin Ling visitors who stay here. There is a pool which opens in late May when the weather permits pool use. Winter rates including taxes, are \$42 to \$57.75/single, \$52.50 to \$68.50/2 people-1 bed. There is a charge of \$5 to \$10 per extra person. Deluxe rooms are available, some with Jacuzzis & a fireplace, for about \$89.25. Summer rates are approximately \$10 more. The Motel Trinity is located on the Main St. in Weaverville. It has a pool and some in-room jacuzzis with very, large tubs! There are kitchenettes in several rooms. Every room has a microwave and coffee makers. Some rooms have TVs w/DVD's or videos. It is located next to Mc Donough's Bakery which serves lattes, espresso coffee and homemade goodies. Rates, **including** taxes, are \$42/single, \$52.50/double (one bed), \$68.25/double (two beds), \$78.75/4 , \$90-\$120/Spa for 2 people. \$80 & up for room with three beds. The Weaverville Victorian Inn is located on the far eastern end of Weaverville. It offers 60 large deluxe rooms with two queen beds in each room. Commercial rates during the week **before** taxes are \$54.99/single, \$64.99/ two people, \$69.99/ three people, \$72.99/four people. There are also 17 suites with hot tubs. Each room has one king size bed and goes for \$85.99. During weekends, the rates go up approximately \$45 more a night. There is a swimming pool. Call (530) 623-4432. Big Foot Campground and RV Park Three miles west of Junction City on route 299 is the Big Foot Campground and RV Park. A private campground on the Trinity River with coin-operated showers and laundry. It has eight formal tent sites, but can accommodate from 50 to 100 campers. There are 26 RV sites with full hook-ups. Each tent site has a barbecue grill, table and running water. Campers and vans not needing hook-ups, will be accommodated at the tent sites at the tent rate unless those sites are filled, at which point they can stay in RV sites for an additional fee. There are 2 fully furnished cabins with 2 queen sized beds in each cabin with room for other occupants on covered porches overlooking the Trinity River. Also has a beautiful pool and store. Rates: *Tent sites* for groups of 10 or more - \$5.00/person.

Tent sites for families under 10 people - \$17/2 people, \$2 for each extra person, (children 4 years and under admitted without charge)

RV - \$23/2 people per night, \$2/per each extra person

Cabins - Both cabins have full kitchen and full bath

\$85/2 people (one bedroom, sleeps 4 people), \$10.00 extra per person over 4 years.

\$95/2 people (two bedroom, sleeps 6 people - one room has bunkbeds in addition to queen bed)

BLM Campground

Also on Route 299 in Junction City is the Bureau of Land Management operated campground. Campsites each offer a grill and table. There are no showers (though the Trinity River, very nice during the hot season, is right there). Normally BLM charges \$7 per vehicle per night on a first come, first serve basis and there is a two-week limit. Those camping at the BLM campground can shower at the Rigdzin Ling campground.
