Spelling Words: me do³ and go at (The “e” in “me” and the “o” in “go” are underlined to show that they are saying their name, not their first sound. The “o” in “do” has a three above it because it says its third sound, “oo”.)

Phonograms: sh (When giving the practice test, say “write the phonogram that says “Shh, be quiet”)

As you can see, we are beginning our spelling words! The children are all very excited about this. Each week we will give you the spelling words and weekly phonogram or phonograms. You will give them the word orally and have them write the spelling word once by a symbol such as an apple, sun, etc. This will be clear when you see the Practice Test paper come home on Wednesday.
